

Cambridge School First Grade Supply List

Dear Parents,

Below you will find a list of supplies that your child will need for the start of school. Please note the quantity, size, color, and brand name for each item. We have found that these brands work the best for little hands, as well as last the longest! Thank you all very much and we are looking forward to spending First Grade with your sweet child!

- 2 boxes of **10 count Crayola markers** (Classic colors only, wide grip, no scents) (One box will be saved in the classroom to use mid-year when the first box dries out)
- 2 boxes of **12 count Ticonderoga pre-sharpened #2 pencils**
- 1 box **slider zip storage bags** (gallon size) (Please make sure it has the slider and not the press-and-seal kind.)
- 1 box **sandwich sized storage bags** (These can be press-and-seal kind.)
- 1 pack of **3 Pink Pearl erasers**
- 1 pack of **6 small .21 oz. Elmer's Glue sticks**
- 1 **4 fl oz bottle of liquid Elmer's glue**
- 1 pair of **5" blunt tip scissors**
- 1 pack of **Expo dry erase markers** (Any quantity and color is fine; can be fine or chisel tip)
- 1 pack of **standard Post-It notes** (Any quantity and color is fine)
- 3 large rolls of **paper towels**
- 3 containers of **Clorox wipes**
- 1 **sketchbook** (under \$5 [example](#))
- 1 **Medium size Backpack** big enough to hold lunch box, jacket, and take-home folder every day
- A **complete change of seasonally appropriate clothes** in a clear gallon-size bag labeled with your child's name - Does not need to comply with the uniform

Please note:

- Please label the backpack, as well as any lunch, thermos, or snack containers that you will be sending back and forth. We will label the items staying in the classroom.
- We will be providing take-home folders, crayons, and colored pencils, so there is no need to purchase these items. We have a surplus of these supplies from last year, so we may be asking for these items later in the year if we are running low.
