

Supply List for Rising 8th Grade 2023-2024

Unit and Classroom Use:

- Calendar or a homework planner of your own choosing to write down daily homework, which will also help you organize & break down long-term projects into smaller steps nightly/weekly
- 5 1-inch binders (1 for science labs and handouts) OR 1 large binder with well-divided sections with a separate 1-inch binder for science
- Dividers (12)
- Sanford or Sharpie highlighters (1 pack of 6)
- #2 pencils (3 packs: Ticonderoga); mechanical pencils also acceptable
- 1 box of 12-16 count colored pencils (for maps & science)
- Pencil pouch or box for your bin
- Notecard ring with packs of 3X5 notecards for Spanish vocabulary (Like [this one](#))
- Small pencil sharpener with receptacle to hold shavings
- Pens of choice in black, blue, and red or green
- 5 textbook book covers (includes covers for math and science textbooks)
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes
- 1 box of tissues

Math:

- 3 pencils with pencil sharpener OR 3 mechanical pencils
- Pencil case just for math
- 3 fine point dry erase markers
- Sock (for erasing dry erase boards)
- Clear protractor
- \$10 for notebooks and *Scholastic Magazine* (checks made to “Cambridge School”)
- TI-84 PLUS Calculator
- 3 glue sticks
- deck of cards
- 2 dice, regular, six-sided

Science:

- (2) dividers for binder to separate notes and labs.
- Loose leaf paper for notes
- Science-dedicated nature journal (5x7)
- (1) 1” binder for notes and lab handouts
- (1) large stretchy book cover for the science textbook

Unit 1 Virtue Journal Supplies:

The first major project will be to create a Virtue Journal with drawings, illustrations, written stories/descriptions, and artwork of your own design. You will need to purchase this Virtue Journal, but we will show you different examples, so you can decide what kind of journal (size of page, spiral or not, etc.) is best for how you want to do your project.

The materials each person will use at home will vary but may include:
